### **Mathematics:**

*This term we will be linking a lot of our Literacy with our exciting history topic – Ancient Greece. The children will be analysing the features of Greek myths before writing their very own. Throughout this topic the children will be developing their language to help build tension and create atmosphere in their writing.*

### **Science:**

*Our Science topic this term will be Animals including the human body. Children will be particularly focusing on the human circulatory system and identifying human organs. They will be looking at their function and the negative effects that drugs can have on the body.*

### **P.E.:**

*Our Focus this term will be Athletics and Tag Rugby. An outside provider will be taking our sessions on a Friday.*

### **Topic:**

*Our topic this term is Ancient Greece. This topic will run through our literacy, history, geography and art work. The children will be finding out about when and where this period occurred in time. We will be gaining inspiration for our artwork from this period.*

### **PSHE and R.E.**

*This term the children will be studying creation stories from around the world looking at reoccurring themes and differences between them In PSHE the children will be looking at new beginnings and setting targets for themselves.*

### **Literacy:**

*As well as drawing inspiration from Ancient Greek mythology, we will be studying a range of fiction this term. This will focus on pupils creative and imaginative language.*

### **Computing:**

*This term the children will be improving their proficiency using Powerpoint, developing their understanding of hyperlinks. Alongside this they will continue to improve their programming skills using Scratch.*

### **Art, Design and Technology:**

*This term the children will be studying work by the famous artist Andy Warhol. We will be using his techniques to create our own version of art. The children will also be experimenting with different material including pastel and chalk.*
