


Dinosaurs

Literacy

We will be reading stories about dinosaurs!

We are going to revisit instruction writing. We will read 'Dinosaur Farm' and 'How to Grow a Dinosaur' and write our own instructions. We will learn to identify verbs within instructions and begin to use numbers and time connectives when writing. We will read a variety of stories from the 'Harry and his Bucketful of Dinosaurs' set and discuss what we like about these stories and what makes us want to read more.

We are going to write our own exciting dinosaur story 'That's not my Dinosaur!' and look at some dinosaur poetry.

Numeracy

In maths we will be adding three single digit numbers, looking for pairs or bonds to 10 to add first.

We will practise our coin recognition and be able to make small amounts of money using coins.

We will continue to practise addition and subtraction on a number line and revise our bonds to 6, 7 and 10.

We will explore 3D shapes and group them according to their properties.

Science

In science we will be learning about Animals Including Humans. We will be labelling a variety of animals and the body parts of a human. We will group animals into herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

We will continue to learn about the seasonal changes that take place in winter.



Computing



In computing lessons we will continue to learn how to use technology respectfully and safely. We will talk about internet safety.

In PE we will be learning Squash with Andy.

We will work on our body positioning and how this will affect our balance.

Topic



Our topic this half term is Dinosaurs!

We will take a look back in time at what the earth looked like in prehistoric times. We will compare Pangea to how the continents look now and learn the names of the seven continents.

We will find out about different dinosaurs that roamed the earth and how we know what they looked like. We will make our own fossils and small world scenes.
