Mathematics:

We will be focusing on using both mental and written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide. As well as this we will be developing our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages. We will continue to build on our shape knowledge and that of area and perimeter.

Science:

In science we will be learning about solids and liquids. We will understand the difference between the two, whether they can be mixed together or not and how to change one to the other. Mrs Turner will be teaching Year 4 science this half term.

PSHE and R.E.

We will be looking at the theme 'changes.' We will have an R.E day to support our learning of World religions.



Topic:

This half term our topic is 'Rotten Romans.' We will be researching who the Romans were, how they became so powerful, where they conquered and how they still impact on our lives today.

We will investigate the use of printing as a way to create our very own Roman mosaic and will research Roman numerals as well as the Latin language which the Romans used.

By the end of this topic we will have a good understanding of the important figures in Roman history and how their powerful time came to an end.
