


Literacy



During this term, we will look at non-fiction texts and develop biographies, reports, instructions and write letters. Some of this work will link to our Tudor topic. We will also continue to improve aspects of grammar, developing our knowledge of sentence structure.

Numeracy



In our Mathematics work, we will be covering aspects of the following topics:


- Place Value
- Mental and written addition/subtraction
- Properties of quadrilaterals
- Reasoning and Algebra
- Averages, line graphs/pie charts
- Long multiplication and division
- Coordinates and angles

We will do much of this work through investigation and problem solving.

Science

In this curriculum area, we will be looking at Evolution and how animals and plants have adapted to their environment.

Computing



We will consider how information can be shared using multimedia and develop a Tudor presentation, using hyperlinks and embedded media. We will also use 'Flowol', a computer program designed to create logical sequences of actions on a computer.

P.E.

Our focus in P.E. will be football and basketball. We have a specialist coach who comes in on Fridays.



Topic

Our History topic this term is 'The Tudors'. We will begin by placing the Tudor dynasty in the context of a timeline. This will be followed by a more detailed look at the main people associated with the Tudors, such as Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth I. During our Literacy work, we will look at some of the stories behind Shakespeare plays. During the spring term, we will visit Hardwick Hall.
