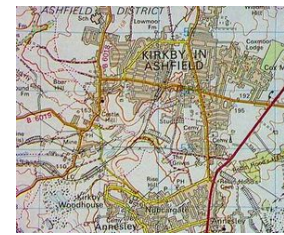


Cool to Live in Kirkby

Literacy



In English we will be reading stories about Katie Morag and comparing where she lives in the Isle of Struay to Kirkby.

We will read the story 'Katie Morag Delivers the Mail'. We will learn how to send a letter and the process from the post box to the recipient's house. We will write to another member of our class and take a trip to the post box to post our letter.

We will explore different clubs and things to do in Kirkby as we read Katie Morag and the Dancing Class.

We will discuss how to behave responsibly within our local environment whilst reading Katie Morag and the Big Boy Cousins.

Numeracy



In maths we will be learning which numbers are odd and even and how we find this out.

We will be introduced to the $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ symbols and understand what they mean. We will find half and a quarter of shapes and numbers.

We will be measuring and comparing weight, capacity and length and record and interpret information using tables and graphs.

Science

In science we will be learning about Plants. We will be learning the names for the parts of a plant and labelling them, carrying out experiments to find out how plants grow best and growing our own sunflowers to observe the growing process. We will be working as a class to look after our Ladybird Garden.
