Why go on a residential...

Throughout this trip, the children will engage in a range of fun, adventurous outdoor activities. These activities will help the children to develop a range of skills, including that of team building, as well as giving them opportunities to face fears.

Over the duration of the residential, the children will engage in a range of different activities alongside children from other schools. These activities will include:

- Cliff Cavern walking
- Performing on an outdoor theatre
- Den building
- Nightline walking
- Problem solving competitions

What do I get for my money?

Breakdown of costs:

Accommodation = £20 (*£1.50 discount for YHM members so reduced to £18.50*).

Meals (one evening meal, one breakfast and one picnic lunch) = £18.50.

Activities (classroom and equipment hire) = £8.00.

Coach = £16 (children will need to be picked up on the Friday at approximately 4pm from the venue)

Total cost = £61 (*with YHM members discount*).

Before we go...

Before starting our adventure, the children will need to ensure that they have the following:

- Plenty of comfortable clothing that you don't mind getting dirty!
- Toiletries
- Maximum of £5 spending money (there is a shop on site which sell souvenirs, snacks and drinks).
