We encourage reading skills beyond the Literacy lesson:

- Worded problems in Numeracy
- Researching topics using books/ ICT Suite/Netbooks
- Encouraging Home-School Reading

We make clear links between reading and writing during Literacy sessions where teachers analyse the model text (shared reading/writing)

GUIDED READING

Focused independent activities:

- Independent comprehension activities based on the GR text.
- Listening to stories on CD player/headphones and following the text.
- Spelling/handwriting based on the spellings/patterns relating to the Literacy work for the week. (investigating the spelling patterns).
- Research topics using ELS books/Netbooks (KS2)

Using the four 'reading areas':

- Shared
- Guided
- Independent
- Focused

Follow up activities based around the guided reading text that give children the chance to answer comprehension questions in an example of focused reading.
