



### Transition Meetings

Meetings are held for parents to introduce them to the school.

### Caterpillars

The children spend half a day per week in the Foundation Unit before starting in our Reception Class. This is facilitated by one of our Midday Supervisors to familiarise children with the lunch time staff.

### Nursery Visits

The Foundation Stage Teachers visit children in their Early Years Setting.

### Mini Royals

A parent and toddler group with games and activities.

## Transition at Kingsway

### Autumn Term

- Reception children have their lunch independently in the dining room.
- They play on the big playground at lunch time with the older children.

### Spring Term

- Attend KS1 Assemblies and Achievement Assembly.
- Begin to have morning break on the big playground with the rest of the school.
- Visits begin from the Year One teachers for one

### Summer Term

- Children have the opportunity to visit Break Club.
- Most assemblies are attended.
- Transition afternoons – children spend one hour per week with their new class in the Year One environment.
- 'Whole School Moves' transition days.

### Curriculum

The children experience an Early Years style of teaching moving towards a more formal style by the end of Autumn Term.

### Transition Meetings
