Sports coach to work with children from different year groups on Tuesdays and Thursdays afterschool and at lunchtimes (see separate timetable).	2 x Lunchtime sessions and 2 x after school sessions. Cost for the year would be £4,200	High quality extra-curricular sessions taught by an experienced professional offering the children a chance to engage in a wide variety of sports.	
4 Supply cover for staff out of school due to sporting events/training courses.	Supply cover to be provided for teachers who attend courses to develop their teaching of PE or who take children to participate in sporting activities during school time.	Approximately £50 to cover one member of teaching staff per half day.	Staff engage with PD to enhance their knowledge, skills, and confidence within the teaching of PE. Children engage in events and competitive sporting activities with children from other schools.	
5 Update equipment and resources.	Car booster seats to coincide with new laws and regulations.	Approximately £30 per car seat (minimum of 4 required)	Children can engage in events and competitive sporting activities with children from other schools.	



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
